HISTORY

First Visit

- Pregnancy
- Birth
- Risk Factors
- FMHx (including siblings)
- SoHx

In addition to questions listed under serial visits

Serial Visits

- **Caregiver concerns**
- Nutrition
- Bowel & Bladder
- Developmental inquiry
- Sleep
- Immunizations
- Safety

PHYSICAL EXAM

- **VITALS**
- **GROWTH:** plotted on growth charts, monitor for crossing of percentiles, failure to thrive, obesity
- **GENERAL:** alertness, activity, dysmorphic features
- **HEENT:** fontanelles, eyes (red reflex, corneal light reflex), neck/torticollis, plagiocephaly
- **CVS:** heart sounds, murmurs, perfusion, femoral pulses
- **RESP:** breath sounds, work of breathing
- **ABDO:** softness, distention, HSM, masses
- **GI/GU:** external genitalia, testes, patent anus
- **MSK:** hips, spine, joint ROM
- **NEURO:** muscle tone, reflexes
- **DERM:** skin (jaundice, rashes, bruising, birthmarks)

Age-specific physical exam at each visit.

NUTRITION

Breastfeeding

- Frequency
- Recommended until 6mo
- Supply & feeding challenges

Formula

- How much, how often
- Calculate TFI

Solids

- Introduce from 4-6mo
- Don't delay introducing allergenic foods (eggs, fish, peanut butter)
- No honey or cow's milk until 1 year of age

Vitamin D

- 400-800 units daily

Iron

- Supplement in premature babies until 1y due to inadequate stores

EDUCATION & ADVICE

Injury Prevention

- Car seats
- Safe sleep and SIDS education
- Falls
- Toxic ingestions
- Firearm safety
- Childproofing the home

Behavior & Family Issues

- Poverty & food insecurity
- Physical activity, sedentary time, screen time
- Reading
- Child-care
- Discipline & parenting skills

Environmental

- Water safety
- Bug spray & sunscreen (>6mo)
- Smoke & CO detectors
- 2nd hand smoke



DEVELOPMENT

Screen for skills in the following domains (milestones vary from child to child):

- Gross Motor
- Fine Motor
- Speech & Language
- Cognitive
- Social/ Emotional



RED FLAGS: failing to meet milestones (requires further assessment), regression

INVESTIGATIONS, SCREENING & IMMUNIZATIONS

Investigations/Screening Universal

- Newborn screening
 - Hearing screen
- Based on Risk**
- Anemia
 - Transmission of bloodborne infections
 - Risk factors for TB

Immunizations

- According to local schedule
